69.10 SNOW EMERGENCY PARKING POLICY

After snowfalls of 3" or more, the snow emergency policy requires odd/even parking on designated snow routes for the first 24 hours in correlation with the day of the month. Even numbered days park on the even (house number) side of the street. The parking will alternate until the snow has stopped and all streets are cleared. The city also has "Snow Emergency" routes where no parking is allowed until all snow has been removed. The City has the right, power, and authority to determine the length of time that parking is not allowed on the streets for snow removal. Vehicles violating the restrictions will be subject to a ticket, minimum \$25.00 fine, and possible towed.
