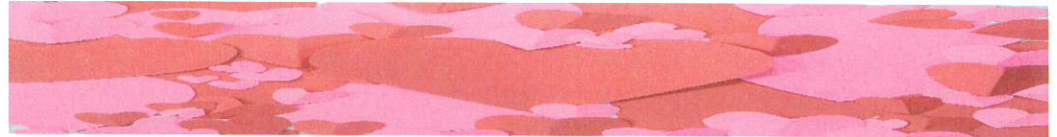

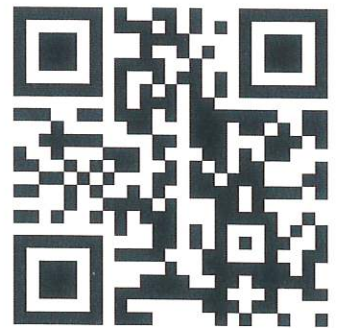
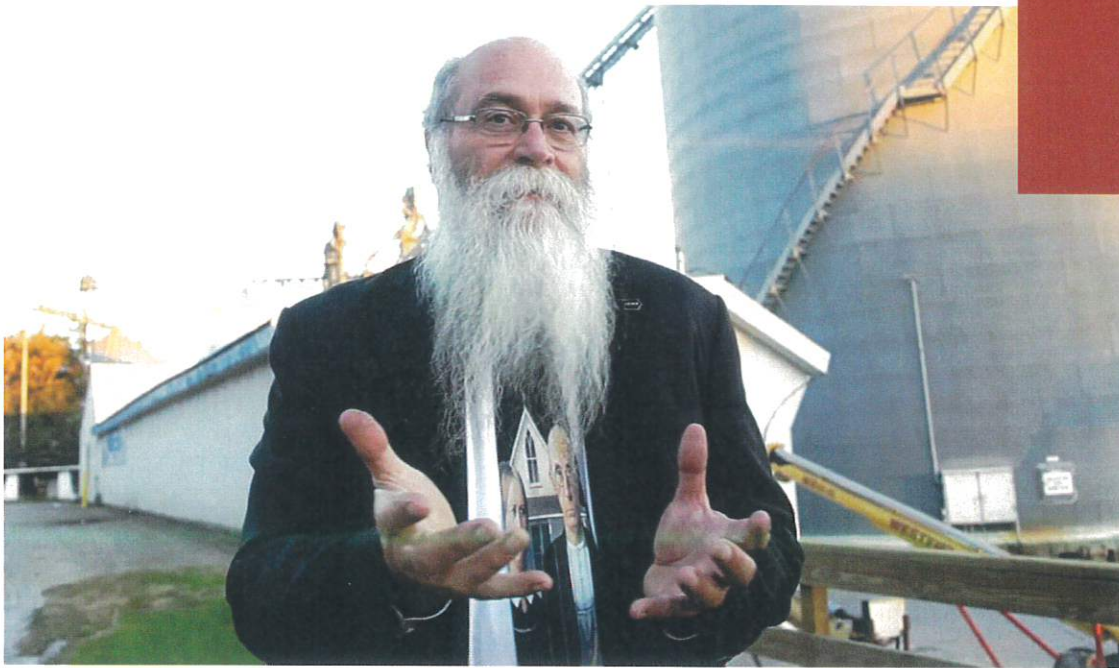
THE HISTORY OF RIVERSIDE
