

ITC Midwest will be completing aerial inspections of our rural high-voltage lines – including the lines in the Kalona and Riverside area. These are called LiDAR surveys and are completed by using a military surplus Mi-2 twin turbine helicopter with dark green and tan camouflage paint. These helicopters will be flying at low altitudes of 300-400 feet to ensure survey integrity. It's completely normal practice – but you may have folks concerned and coming to you with questions!

The plan is to complete these surveys during the second half of September, weather permitting.
