

Cherry Lane Extension Project – The development of a network of new streets will begin shortly after school is out of session for the summer. This new development has been designed to eliminate the need for motorists to use Schnoebelen Street as a primary thoroughfare and will allow non-school related vehicular activity to bypass the school traffic and provide the opportunity to improve dedicated drop-off lanes for the school.
