RIVERSIDE CITY COUNCIL MEETING; February 21, 2017

The Riverside City Council meeting opened at 6:32 pm in City Hall with Mayor Pro-Tem Ralph Schnoebelen requesting roll call. Council members present were: Rob Weber, Bob Schneider Jr., Tom Sexton, and Jeanine Redlinger.

Schneider moved to approve agenda. Second by Redlinger, passed 5-0.

Schneider moved to approve 2/06/17 minutes. Second by Weber, passed 5-0.

Motion by Schneider to omit two MMS bills from expenditures for more details. Second by Weber, passed 5-0.

Sexton moved to pay remaining expenditures. Second by Redlinger, passed 5-0.

Citizens Comments; Andy Rodgers, Rene Arps, and Kathy Lindhorst asked the Council about the removal of the Barn Quilt from the Museum. Council requested that they return to a future meeting with placement suggestions.

Sexton moved to table the decision to hire a Realtor for Cherry Lane. Second by Redlinger, passed 5-0.

Jeff Huber of Greiner Buildings answered Council questions on the park shelter design concept. Schneider moved to approve Greiner Buildings for a concept design at a cost of \$2500. Second by Redlinger, passed 5-0.

Bill Stukey, PeopleService, Inc. presented monthly Water and Wastewater reports. Ferguson will start new meter installation on 2-27-17.

Building Permit Fees were discussed. Resolution #022117-01 was tabled. Jay Skuelke and Chad Sands will be asked to attend the March 20th Council Meeting.

Several options were presented for Property Tax Rebates on a New Business. Incentives would be paid with Casino Funds. Weber moved to rebate 100% with a 10% reduction each year for 10 years. No second was made. Schneider moved to rebate 100% for three years, then 10% reduction each year for six years total. Second by Weber, passed 5-0.

Redlinger moved to approve quote of repairs to the Community Building from Smock Companies for \$1135.44, with RACC providing labor. Second by Schneider, passed 5-0.

Weber moved to table Resolution # 022117-02 Truck Purchase. Second by Schneider, passed 5-0.

Weber moved to pass Resolution #022117-03 Law Enforcement Contract FY 17-18 with Washington County for \$ 53,089.00. Second by Sexton, passed 5-0.

Council held discussion on the status of the Sr. Dining meal program. Redlinger is checking into other options.

Council Comments; Schneider asked about 2016 City wages. They were published in the 2-16-17 paper. Redlinger read a statement of opposition to the State Bill that just passed on Healthcare Insurance for State Employees. Sexton requested that the Council address conditions of "City Right of Way" on all City ditches in the near future. Weber issued "thank-you" to city staff for the additional budget information and meetings, Bill Stukey for water reports, RACC for concern of Barn Quilt, and Kalona News for the enhanced Riverside coverage in the paper. Schnoebelen added his thanks to City Staff for all the time put into budget preparations.

Sexton moved to adjourn at 9:15 pm. Second by Redlinger, passed 5-0.
