RIVERSIDE CITY COUNCIL MEETING: June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2017

The Riverside City Council meeting opened at 6:32 pm in City Hall with Mayor Allen Schneider requesting roll call. Council members present were: Bob Schneider Jr., Jeanine Redlinger, Tom Sexton, Rob Weber, and Ralph Schnoebelen.

Motion by Schneider to approve the agenda. Second by Weber, passed 5-0.

Schneider moved to approve the minutes from May 15<sup>th</sup>, a RACC liquor license, and the expenditures. Second by Weber, passed 5-0.

Schneider moved to go into closed session pursuant to Iowa Code Section 21.5(1)(j) Real Estate at 6:43 pm. Second by Schnoebelen, passed 5-0.

Sexton moved to return to open meeting at 7:25 pm. Second by Weber, passed 5-0. Sexton motioned to proceed with real estate as directed by council. Second by Redlinger, passed 5-0.

Glen Meisner and Scott Pottorff of MMS Consultants updated the council on street projects.

During project updates, Dave Schmitt Construction did some sewer line televising in the amount of \$744.00. Meisner asked the Council if they would pay this bill directly. Motion by Redlinger, seconded by Sexton to pay the televising bill. Passed 5-0.

There was some emergency masonry work done to a couple of the buildings during the project by Ruess Masonry in the amount \$1,635.00. Meisner asked the Council if they would also pay this bill directly. Motion by Weber, seconded by Schneider to pay Ruess Masonry bill. Passed 4-1 with Sexton voting no.

Sexton moved to pass Resolution #060517-01 for Dave Schmitt Construction change order #2 for relocating required water main on River & Pioneer Streets at a cost of \$6,719.25. Second by Weber, passed 5-0.

Sexton moved to pass Resolution #060517-02 Dave Schmitt Construction change order #5 to relocate the overhead electrical on Washburn Street to underground for \$10,780.00. Second by Weber, passed 5-0.

Kevin Mills' request for reimbursement for lawn expenses was tabled until the next meeting.

Price quotes for the concrete drive at the Waste Water Plant was tabled until the next meeting.

Discussion was had about the placement of the barn quilt. Schneider motioned to place the quilt on the Fire Station, seconded by Sexton, motion failed by a 2-3 vote, Schneider and Sexton voting yes and Schnoebelen, Redlinger and Weber voting no. After more discussion, motion by Redlinger, seconded by Weber, to place the quilt on the barn at Hall Park. Motion failed 2-3, Redlinger and Weber voting yes, Schneider, Sexton and Schnoebelen voting no. A motion was made by Weber, seconded by Schnoebelen, to put the quilt at the museum for display for 90 days. Passed 5-0.

Council discussed new state law for the sale of fireworks. There have been a few calls to City Hall about obtaining permits to sell fireworks. After review several examples from other cities, Council directed City Clerk to check with City Attorney on recommendations for how to deal with the new legislation. Motion by Schneider, seconded by Sexton, to table until next meeting. Motion carried, 5-0.

Discussion was had about the property located at 191 W 1<sup>ST</sup> Street. The State Code of lowa has a provision in Section 657A.10A that a City may acquire title to abandoned properties through the court system. Motion by Redlinger, seconded by Schneider to proceed with the process, working through the City Attorney.

The "Welcome Sign" on the west side of town was damaged during the last storm. Discussion was had about replacing the sign. More discussion will be held at the next meeting.

The second reading to amend the Solid Waste Ordinance was read. Motion by Schnoebelen, seconded by Redlinger to set the collection rates at \$5.25 per month. Stickers will remain at \$1.25 each. The third reading was waived. Passed 5-0.

A work session is scheduled to be held on June 15<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 in the City Council Chambers with John Danos of Dorsey and Whitney to discuss options for incentives to new businesses and new construction. In that same work session, we will also be discussing the next phase of the downtown revitalization, the Pioneer Street Project.

Another work session was set for June 27<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 to discuss our options for solar arrays at the Water and Waste Water Treatment Facilities. The public is welcome and encouraged to attend any public meeting or work session.

Motion by Redlinger, seconded by Sexton to approve Resolution #060517-03, to set the date for Public Hearing to sell lot #14 in the Cherry Lane Subdivision. Passed 5-0.

After the storm a few weeks ago, there have been several piles of sticks around town. Schnoebelen made a motion, seconded by Weber, to have stick pick up on June  $14^{\rm th}$  and then no more stick pick up until October. Motion passed 5-0.

The City did not receive any proposals from the public to pay the City for removal of the sheds or concrete located on the Van Zante's property. Motion by Schnoebelen, seconded by Redlinger to leave the property as is for now. Passed 5-0.

Motion by Sexton, seconded by Schnoebelen to have the parks sprayed for mosquito control the same as we did last year. Passed 5-0.

Washington County Economic Development sent a letter asking for the continued support of \$1,500.00 annually. Motion by Schneider, seconded by Weber, to continue the annual amount. Passed 5-0.

A short discussion was had about the remaining water meters left to be installed. The Mayor and the City Clerk will continue communication with homeowners to get things completed.

Bill Stukey with PeopleService is looking into phone service for the Water & Waste Water Plants for OmniSite alarms. He will include the information in his next monthly report.

Questions had come up about the state laws regarding City spending limits with Schnoebelen Inc. Council will discuss this further at a later date when more information is collected from the State Auditor and the City Attorney.

Weber moved to adjourn at 10:03 pm. Second by Redlinger, passed 5-0.

## **RESOLUTION #061917-01**

## RESOLUTION TO SELL LOT #14 IN THE CHERRY LANE SUBDIVISION TO TWRVR PROPERTIES, LLC

**WHEREAS**, the City of Riverside, Iowa, held a public hearing on the Sale of Lot #14, in the Cherry Lane Subdivision to TWRVR Properties, LLC, on June 19th, 2017 in the City Council Chambers located at the Riverside City Hall, 60 North Greene Street, Riverside, Iowa. There were not any written or oral objections to the sale.





Scott, last year the City of Riverside installed sanitary sewer behind the Casey's store in Riverside. There was an agreement for Casey's to pay for half of the cost of this improvement. The City is finally going to accept these improvements (The contractor left some things undone over the winter and just last week finally finished everything) at its' Council meeting on Monday night. ## AGREEMENT FOR SANITARY SEWER CONSTRUCTION Between CITY OF RIVERSIDE and CASEY'S MARKETING COMPANY

The sanitary sewer service for the Casey's General Store in Riverside, Iowa has been a maintenance problem for the City over the past several years. The City of Riverside proposed to install a sanitary sewer main in place of a portion of the service and reconnect the service to the new main. The estimated quantities and costs for this sanitary sewer main are attached as Exhibit A. Therefore, the City of Riverside, Iowa (hereinafter referred to as "CITY"), and Casey's Marketing Company (hereinafter referred to as "CASEY'S) agree to the following:

- 1. The CITY shall install the sanitary sewer in general accordance with the quantities shown on Exhibit A. CASEY'S agrees to reimburse the CITY for 50% of the total costs in the estimate to install the sanitary sewer, including construction, engineering and administration costs. CITY shall provide plans for the construction and shall solicit bids from at least two contractors for the work. CITY shall oversee construction and accept the sanitary sewer as a public improvement once complete. CITY shall provide documentation of all costs to CASEY'S after construction is complete and accepted for reimbursement.
- 2. CASEY'S shall be responsible for future maintenance of their sanitary sewer service between the building and the new sanitary sewer main in accordance with City codes.
- 3. CITY shall be responsible for future maintenance of the sanitary sewer main in a similar manner to other sanitary sewer mains in the City.

## Water Operation & Maintenance

- ➤ Emergency locate for broken power pole on 4<sup>th</sup> St at 7 AM. Completed
- Flushed, oiled, greased all fire hydrants. Water pumped for the month is higher due to flushing hydrants.
- > PH probe at water plant failed to calibrate and accurately measure PH. Replaced with new probe on 5-23-17.
- > Painted 18 fire hydrants. More will be painted throughout the summer.
- Keunster Plumbing and Heating worked on A/C at water plant. Unit was failing to run. Diagnosis was fuses were blown from the compressor drawing too high of amperage. Keunster P&H recommends replacing whole unit or pump in the near future, they will be providing Peopleservice with a quote. A/C unit is primarily needed for keeping the electrical control room cool during summer months.
- > Small chlorine leak was detected in chemical feed room on chlorine pump #2. Air release line had a small pinhole, total amount lost was approximately 2-3 fluid ounces. Air release line was replaced. Chlorine was contained in skid tray and cleaned up. Pump #2 is back in service.
- 28 locates during month of May, all were completed.

## Wastewater Operation & Maintenance






adjusting the level set points on the controller. Controller has been reset to original settings after the high flow event ended.


- > Trash liner was changed on the screen unit at wastewater plant.

## RESOLUTION APPROVING THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS FOR THE 2016-2017 BUDGET YEAR

**WHEREAS**, the City of Riverside exercises the right to transfer funds per the certified budget for Fiscal Year 2016-2017.

- 1. Transfer \$ 55,000 from the General Fund to the Capital Projects Fund for capital projects per the certified budget.
- 2. Transfer \$65,400 (60%) from the LOST Fund to the Capital Projects Fund per ballot.
- 3. Transfer \$43,600 (40%) from the LOST Fund to the General Fund per ballot.
- 4. Transfer \$973,000 from the Casino Revenue Fund to the Capital Projects Fund for capital projects per the certified budget.
- 5. Transfer \$75,000 from Water Fund to Capital Projects Fund for capital Projects per certified budget.
- 6. Transfer \$18,900 from Storm Water Maintenance Fund to Capital Projects Fund for capital projects per certified budget.

<b>THEREFORE,</b> be it hereby resolved, the City of Riverside City Council directs the City Clerk to transfer funds in the amount of \$1,230,900 as approved for the 2016/2017 budget year.
