Attached is the updated plan and pricing for connecting the storm sewers together north of the highway and abandoning the west storm sewer by filling with flowable mortar. It leaves the new storm under the highway and to the south at 18" instead of upsizing to the 24" which I discussed at the Council meeting. Also included is replacing 32 feet of 15" storm sewer north of the new manhole to get the storm sewer low enough to get cover at the new manhole.

Attached is the original ITC #3 plan with the original proposed pricing as presented to the Council Monday night. This would leave the storm sewer on the west side like existing. If this plan went forward the idea would be to connect the storm sewers together on the north side of the highway when Glasgow is improved in the future. The storm under the highway would be abandoned at that point. There would need to be intakes installed on both sides of Glasgow to capture the runoff once the street is improved so these intakes would connect to the storm on the east side and the west side would be abandoned.
