RIVERSIDE CITY COUNCIL MEETING: September 4, 2018

Council had a work session with Kris Westfall for Galileo Drive at 5:30 pm. Council discussed lot pricing, and problems with construction traffic using Schnoebelen Street. Letters have been sent to property owners, and City Staff talked to drivers today.

The Riverside City Council meeting opened at 6:30 pm in City Hall with Mayor Allen Schneider requesting roll call. Council members present were: Andy Rodgers, Tom Sexton, Bob Schneider Jr., and Jeanine Redlinger.

Motion by Schneider to approve the agenda, Second by Redlinger, passed 4-0.

Rodgers moved to approve the minutes from August 20<sup>th</sup>, August 23<sup>rd</sup>, and the expenditures. Second by Sexton, passed 4-0.

Chris Kirkwood addressed Council about truck traffic on Schnoebelen Street.

Bill Poch recommended Ralph Schnoebelen to fill council vacancy.

Council received comments from Edgar McGuire, Kevin Mills, and Ralph Schnoebelen on willingness to fill vacancy.

Sexton moved to pass Resolution 090418-01; Appointing Kevin Mills to fill the vacant council seat until December 31, 2019. Motion died due to lack of second.

Redlinger moved to pass Resolution 090418-01; Appointing Ralph Schnoebelen to fill vacant council seat until December 31, 2019. Second by Schneider, passed 3-1. Sexton opposed.

Brian McDole submitted request to have large tree removed from state right of way. Staff will contact lowa DOT for ruling.

Rodgers moved to approve sewer permit for McCreedy-Ruth Construction, LLC at 3105 Hwy 22, Riverside. Second by Redlinger, passed 4-0.

Sexton moved to approved sewer permit for Midwest Poly-Solutions Properties, LLC at 3102 115<sup>th</sup> Street, Riverside. Second by Schneider, passed 4-0.

Planning and Zoning submitted minutes from the August 27<sup>th</sup> meeting.

Jason Shalla discussed plans to build rental unit on his property located at 190 N Washington. Plans will be sent to P&Z.

Kevin Meller gave final Trek Fest and Ragbrai reports.

Schneider moved to pass Resolution 090418-02; Set the Date for Public Hearing for Accepting Final Plat for Galileo Drive at the September 17<sup>th</sup> Council Meeting, which begins at 6:30 pm. Second by Sexton, passed 4-0.

APEX Construction and Jeff Edberg presented final copy of the Northern Heights Agreement. Council will hold a work session on Monday, September  $10^{\rm th}$  to work on agreement.

Schneider moved to pass Resolution 090418-03; setting Public Hearing for the Northern Heights Development Agreement for September 17, 2018. Second by Redlinger, passed 3-1. Sexton opposed.

Redlinger moved to pass Resolution 090418-04; Approving Change Order #9 for J&L Construction, LLC for replacement of lead water service at 51 W 1<sup>st</sup> Street in the Downtown Streetscape project. Second by Schneider, passed 4-0.

Schneider moved to pass Resolution 090418-05; Approving Change Order #10 for J&L Construction, LLC for lowering the intake in the alley behind 51 E 1<sup>st</sup> Street in the Downtown Streetscape Project. Second by Rodgers, passed 4-0.

Bill Stukey, PeopleService, Inc. gave July water and waste water report. Well # 8 has enough dirt. Dozer will come in and level off when dry. LS#1 generator needs repairs. Schneider moved to repair generator for the estimated cost of \$7800.00. Second by Redlinger, passed 4-0.

Schneider moved to have J&L Construction patch repair on W61 north of bridge for estimated cost of \$2500.00. Second by Rodgers, passed 4-0.

Rodgers moved pass Resolution 090418-06 Street Financial Report for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2018. Second by Sexton, passed 4-0.

Schneider moved to allow Mayor to get additional quotes for new City Hall Computer Server, and order a system, not to exceed \$12,665.98. Second by Rodgers, passed 4-0.

Bryan Lenz presented 4 bids for replacement skid loader tires. Tabled.

Mayor requested Council Work Session for September 10<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 pm.

Rodgers moved to adjourn at 9:29 pm. Second by Redlinger, passed 4-0.

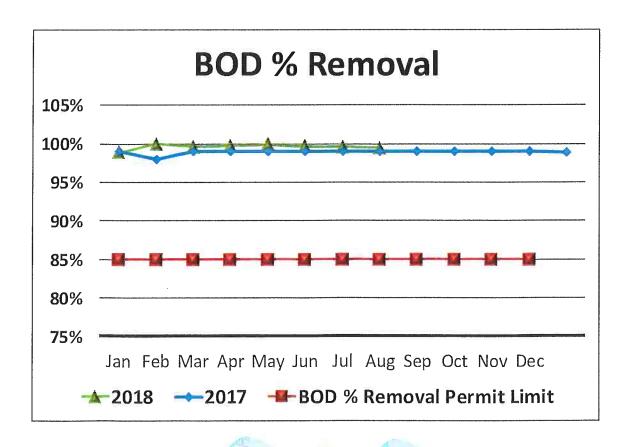
- > Eric replaced the curb box and rod at a residence on 4<sup>th</sup> St. The old box and rod were discovered to be broken when being operated by the homeowner.

This greatly reduces the amount of water used and the overall bill the consumer will pay.

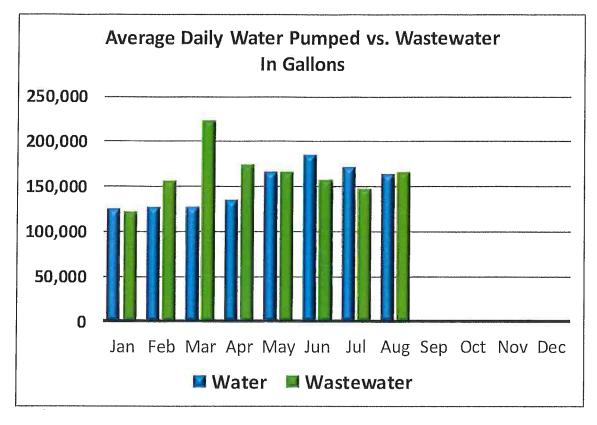
