RIVERSIDE CITY COUNCIL MEETING: October 15, 2018

The Riverside City Council meeting opened at 6:30 pm in City Hall with Mayor Allen Schneider requesting roll call. Council members present were: Andy Rodgers, Tom Sexton, Bob Schneider Jr., Jeanine Redlinger, and Ralph Schnoebelen.

Motion by Sexton to approve the agenda, Second by Schnoebelen, passed 5-0.

Schneider moved to approve the minutes from October 1st, expenditures without #12, and Fire Department September update. Second by Rodgers, passed 5-0.

Chris Kirkwood addressed Council on State Audit, HR Audit, and water main repairs on Schnoebelen Street.

Representatives from DVIP presented proclamation for recognizing October as Domestic Violence Awareness Month.

Tree removal at 10 Washington Street was moved to next meeting to look up Code of Ordinance regulations, and to clarify bids.

Board of Adjustments Appointments; Schnoebelen moved to appoint Phil Richman. Second by Rodgers, passed 5-0. Redlinger moved to appoint Kathy Lindhorst. Second by Schneider, passed 4-1 Sexton opposed.

Rodgers moved to open Public Hearing at 7:06 pm for Rezoning 111 Knisel Street. Second by Schnoebelen, passed 5-0. Denny Bush asked about off street parking and green space. Redlinger expressed concern of storm water issues, exit onto Hwy 22, and respecting property lines. Scott Pottorff, MMS stated that the land use is currently R-3. Sexton moved to close Public Hearing at 7:21 pm. Second by Schnoebelen, passed 5-0.

Schneider moved to pass Ordinance #101518-01; Approving Rezoning of 111 Knisel Street from R-2 Mixed residential to R-3 Multifamily Residential, with Site Plan presented to P&Z before construction. Second by Sexton, passed 4-1 Redlinger opposed. 2nd Reading will be at the November 5th council meeting.

Rodgers moved to pass Resolution 101518-02; Setting the date of November 5^{th} for the Public Hearing to sell Lot #7 in Cherry Lane Subdivision to John Crumly for \$35,000.00. Second by Schnoebelen, passed 5-0.

Scott Pottorff, MMS Consultants gave updates on Capital Projects.

Redlinger moved to grout corner openings in light pole bases. Second by Sexton, passed 5-0.

Schnoebelen moved to pass Resolution 101518-04; Approving Pay Request #7 for J&L Construction, in the amount of \$280,053.05 for the Downtown Streetscape Project. Second by Rodgers, passed 5-0.

Galileo Drive should be done by the end of week. Sidewalks are done and lot pins are getting installed. Sexton moved to extend completion date to October 22, 2018 due to wet conditions.

Sexton moved to pass Resolution #101518-03; Approving Interstate Power and Light Company Electric Facilities Extension for street lights on Galileo Drive. Second by Rodgers, passed 5-0.

Schneider moved to pass Resolution #101518-05; Approving Change Order #2 to Triple B Construction for design changes in the Hwy 22 Improvement Project in the amount of \$50.00 credit. Second by Sexton, passed 5-0.

Schnoebelen moved to send Northern Heights Subdivision Preliminary Plat to the P&Z Committee for review. Second by Rodgers, passed 4-1 Sexton opposed.

Schnoebelen moved to have City staff repair ditch at 241 E 4th Street. Second by Redlinger, passed 5-0.

Council reviewed correspondence with the Washington county Engineer pertaining to the County GPS Monument Marker in the City right of way on the east side of 101 Cherry Lane. Pottorff will ask for repairs to be completed by March 1, 2019.

Bill Stukey, PeopleService, Inc. presented September water and waste water report.

Staff will send letters to residents on 2nd Street addressing parking Ordinance.

Schnoebelen moved to have City Clerk advertise the 1971 Chevy C70 fire truck with 8800 miles, For Sale, by sealed bids, until November 15th. Second by Rodgers, passed 5-0.

Schnoebelen moved to review Audit FY17 at a work session. Second by Redlinger, passed 5-0.

Redlinger moved to proceed with renting the upper unit at $40 \, \text{E} \, 2^{\text{nd}}$ street. Second by Schnoebelen, passed 5-0.

Kyle Saulter of $3135\ 115^{\text{th}}$ Street asked Council to hook up to City water. Bill Stukey will work with him to get estimate of costs.

Schnoebelen moved to allow Saulter to hook up to City line at his expense. Second by Redliger, passed 5-0.

Mayor reported on Downtown Community Grant meeting, and the Washington County Housing Study.

Sexton asked about the new DOT Incident By-Pass signs.

Rodgers moved to adjourn at 9:10 pm. Second by Redlinger, passed 5-0.

- 1. The meeting was called to order by Nate Robinson, Vice-Chairperson, in the absence of Ryan Rogerson. The roll was taken and a quorum was present.
- 2. Pottorff discussed a letter that itemized the MMS engineering issues and concerns associated with the preliminary plat for the northern development.

The name of Roetlin Street should be changed to Galileo, as it is a continuation of that street to the west. Street names have been changed to conform on the new plat.

The storm sewer has been changed and this will be reflected on the final version that goes to the council.

The issue of making Roetlin a collector street with wider dimensions and setbacks was discussed. This is the renamed street running east and west on the north side. This takes up more area and addresses such a small area that it wasn't felt necessary.

Out Lot A is the water retention basin that will be owned by the city; a smaller retention basin to the north will be privately owned and maintained. This serves the area of Lot 20, which is zoned R3, multiple family.

Sidewalks and Safe Route to School sidewalks along Tupelo were not under the jurisdiction of this committee and will be addressed at a Council Work Session.

The plat map shows the western boundary for this area extending into Tulip. Scott will call the county to clarify why it is shown this way on the plat. If accurate, there will need to be easements or permissions from the county.

- 3. The next step in this process is to present final plans for Phase I of the project (lots 1-12) to the council for approval.
- 4. Ed McGuire moved and Marcy Musser seconded to recommend approval of the plat to the Council at it's next meeting. It passed unanimously.

5. A motion was made to approve the minutes of the September 24, 2018, meeting and it was passed unanimously.

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 6 p.m. in City Hall.
- 2. Roll call showed all members present:

- 3. The Commission was called to order and unanimously voted to approve the P&Z minutes from the August 27, 2018, meeting.
- 4. The Commission reviewed a preliminary plat for the Northern Growth Development. This area will be served by water and sewer lines that were put in for Cherry Lane and Galileo. The lots on the plat provide for single family dwellings, duplexes and multi-family units that require R2 and R3 zoning. R2 zoning allows for 70-foot lot widths for single family units. The water retention basis will be owned and maintained by the city. There is a possible future issue of creating an island of the parcel owned by Kurt Schnoebelen, but Pottorf pointed out that the 80/20 rule provides a way to force annexation to avoid this, if necessary. Neither Apex nor Jeff Edberg has contacted the property owner to advise them of this. Several members felt the family should at least be notified of this situation. Robinson moved and Rogerson seconded to recommend approval of annexation of both parcels to the city council. This motion passed unanimously. Rogerson moved and McGuire seconded to recommend zoning Parcel 1 as R2 and Parcel 2 as R3 to the city council. This motion also passed unanimously.
- 5. The preliminary plan for the duplex that Jason Shalla proposes to build on Washington Street was discussed. It includes two rental units (top and bottom) of approximately 920 square feet with no basement. There will be parking in front and sidewalks on two sides. Jason plans to put in 6-8 parking spaces; four are required. Kirkwood moved and Rogerson seconded to recommend approval of the preliminary plan to the city council. There was a question raised whether the lot was big enough by code to be buildable. If not, it will still have to be referred to the Board of Adjustment by the city council.

A map and preliminary plans were reviewed for building a six-plex at 111 Knisel Street by TWRVR Properties, where another four-plex unit already exists. All of the units will be rentals and the new building requires R3 zoning; the property is currently R2. After some discussion concerning traffic and the property location on the highway, Rogerson moved and Kirkwood seconded to recommend approval to zone the entire parcel (including the current building) R3 to the city council. This motion passed unanimously (Musser left at 6:45 pm to attend another meeting).

7. A preliminary plan and photo of proposed zero lot line units to be built by Don Prybil was reviewed by the commission. This property is already annexed and zoned C3 and lies east of the Travel Mart at the corner of Highway 22 and Vine Avenue. The county has a gravel road up to this parcel that is currently blocked off. Prybil explained that there will be ten buildings with two streets so that they can all be walk-out units and they will be owned individually, not rented. Pottorf pointed out that each unit needs to front to a public street conforming to city code, as planned here. Rogerson

moved and Cloyed seconded to send the preliminary proposal to city council recommending approval of the development concept. This motion passed unanimously.

- 8. The preliminary plat for the River North subdivision on Vine Avenue in Washington County planned by Todd Hahn was reviewed. Discussion about possible future annexation, costs for utilities, and lot sizes followed. The issue for Planning and Zoning is confined to waiving the city's review of this development because it lies within two miles of Riverside city limits, but this waiver does not preclude any future annexation agreement that might be reached. Kirkwood moved and Robinson seconded to recommend to city council to waive review of the Hahn subdivision. This motion passed unanimously.
- 9. Rogerson moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:20 p.m., unanimously approved. The next scheduled meeting will be held Monday, October 22, at 6 p.m.

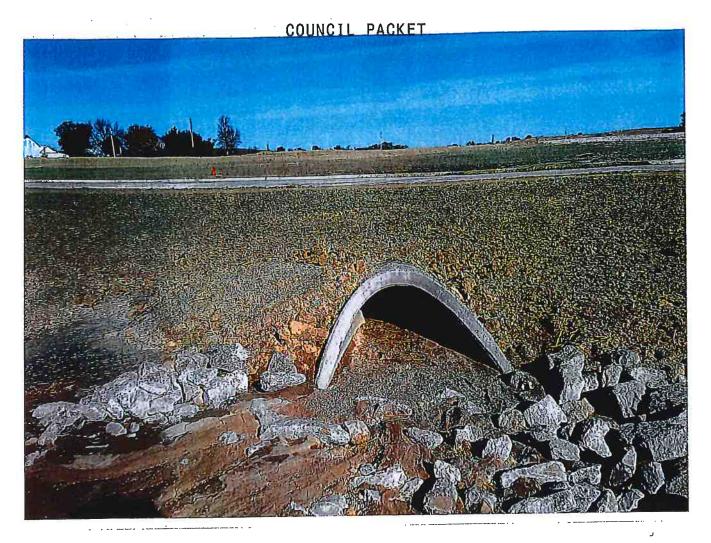

BASIC SERVICES SHALL INCLUDE:

The intent of this phase is to obtain and accurate topographic and boundary survey of the project area. The extent of the topographic survey is expected to be along Ash Street/Tupelo Boulevard extending from Blackberry Street to the north end of the Northern Heights Development. Work under this phase is expected to include:

A. Standard of Care will be the care and skill ordinarily used by members of the subject profession practicing under similar circumstances at the same time and in the same locality. MMS makes no warranties, express or implied, under this Agreement or otherwise, in connection with services required to be performed by this Agreement. MMS and its consultants may use or rely upon the design services of others, including, but not limited to, contractors, manufacturers and suppliers.

B. MMS shall not at any time supervise, direct or have control over any contractor's work, nor shall MMS have authority over or responsibility for the means, methods, techniques, sequences, or procedures of construction selected or used by any contractor, for safety precautions and programs incident to a contractor's work progress, nor

for any failure of any contractor to comply with laws and regulations applicable to contractor's work.

C. MMS neither guarantees the performance of any contractor nor assumes responsibility for any contractor's failure to furnish and perform its work in accordance with the contract between Client and such contractor.

D. 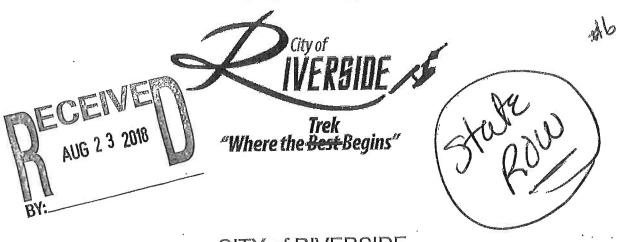

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CHAPTER 151

TREES

151.01 Definition 151.02 Planting Restrictions 151.03 Duty to Trim Trees 151.04 Trimming Trees to be Supervised 151.05 Disease Control 151.06 Inspection and Removal

- 151.01 **DEFINITION.** For use in this chapter, "parking" means that part of the street, avenue or highway in the City not covered by sidewalk and lying between the lot line and the curb line; or, on unpaved streets, that part of the street, avenue or highway lying between the lot line and that portion of the street usually traveled by vehicular traffic.
- 151.02 PLANTING RESTRICTIONS. No tree shall be planted in any parking or street except in accordance with the following:
 - 1. Alignment. All trees planted in any street shall be planted in the parking midway between the outer line of the sidewalk and the curb. In the event a curb line is not established, trees shall be planted on a line ten (10) feet from the property line.
 - 2. Spacing. Trees shall not be planted on any parking which is less than nine (9) feet in width, or contains less than eighty-one (81) square feet of exposed soil surface per tree. Trees shall not be planted closer than twenty (20) feet from street intersections (property lines extended) and ten (10) feet from driveways. If it is at all possible trees should be planted inside the property lines and not between the sidewalk and the curb.
 - 3. Prohibited Trees. No person shall plant in any street any fruit-bearing tree or any tree of the kinds commonly known as cotton wood, poplar, box elder, Chinese elm, evergreen, willow or black walnut.
- 151.03 DUTY TO TRIM TREES. The owner or agent of the abutting property shall keep the trees on, or overhanging the street, trimmed so that all branches will be at least fifteen (15) feet above the surface of the street and eight (8) feet above the sidewalks. If the abutting property owner fails to trim the trees, the City may serve notice on the abutting property owner requiring that such action be taken within five (5) days. If such action is not taken within that time, the City may perform the required action and assess the costs against the abutting property for collection in the same manner as a property tax.

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 364.12[2c, d & e])

- 151.04 TRIMMING TREES TO BE SUPERVISED. Except as allowed in Section 151.03, it is unlawful for any person to trim or cut any tree in a street or public place unless the work is done under the supervision of the City.
- 151.05 DISEASE CONTROL. Any dead, diseased or damaged tree or shrub which may harbor serious insect or disease pests or disease injurious to other trees is hereby declared to be a nuisance.

- 9. Weeds, Brush. Dense growth of all weeds, vines, brush, or other vegetation in the City so as to constitute a health, safety, or fire hazard.
- 10. Dutch Elm Disease. Trees infected with Dutch elm disease. (See also Chapter 151)
- 11. Airport Air Space. Any object or structure hereafter erected within one thousand (1,000) feet of the limits of any municipal or regularly established airport or landing place, which may endanger or obstruct aerial navigation including take-off and landing, unless such object or structure constitutes a proper use or enjoyment of the land on which the same is located.
- 12. Houses of Ill Fame. Houses of ill fame, kept for the purpose of prostitution and lewdness; gambling houses; places resorted to by persons participating in criminal gang activity prohibited by Chapter 723A of the *Code of Iowa* or places resorted to by persons using controlled substances, as defined in Section 124.101 of the *Code of Iowa*, in violation of law, or houses where drunkenness, quarreling, fighting or breaches of the peace are carried on or permitted to the disturbance of others.

Storage of household refuse or appliances, including but not limited to, stoves or ranges, refrigerators, clothes washers or dryers, water heaters, televisions and heating devices upon the grounds of any property or upon any unenclosed porch, breezeway, carport, deck or similar area.
- 14. Excrement of Household Pets. Failing to dispose of, promptly and properly, excrement and waste products associated with household pets or domestic animals or allowing such materials to collect upon or escape from property.
- 15. Number of Household Pets. Harboring or maintaining household pets, domestic animals or livestock in such numbers as to interfere with the peaceful and quiet enjoyment of neighboring properties, by reason of noise, odors, inadequate facilities or strays.
- 50.03 OTHER CONDITIONS. The following actions are required and may also be abated in the manner provided in this chapter:

 - F. Unsafe or exposed electrical service;
 - G. Damaged, inoperative or missing sanitary facilities;

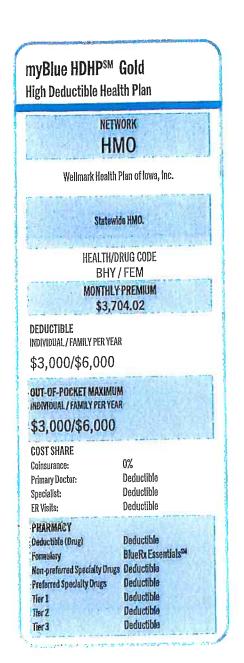

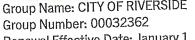
