CONTRACT AND AGREEMENT LAW ENFORCEMENT

This Contract and Agreement is entered into by and between Washington County, Iowa, hereafter called County, and the City of **Riverside**, Iowa, hereafter called City and by consent and agreement of the Washington County, Iowa, Sheriff, hereafter called Sheriff.

The purpose of this Contract and Agreement is to establish a joint exercise of governmental powers as provided by Chapter 28E, 2021 Code of Iowa, which the County will furnish law enforcement services for the City in order to ensure the City's compliance with Iowa law.

No separate legal or administrative entity shall exist by virtue of this Contract and Agreement. The Sheriff is hereby designated as the administrator responsible for administration and fulfillment of this joint Contract and Agreement for the County.

The duration of this Contract and Agreement is for a period of one year commencing at 12:01 a.m. on the first day of July 2021 and continuing until 11:59 p.m. on the last day of June 2022.

In consideration of the services July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022 provided by the County, the City agrees to pay the county at the annual rate of \$131,640.00, in equal quarterly installments of \$32,910.00, by the 15th day of the month following the beginning of the quarter upon receipt of an invoice from the County Auditor.

The County agrees to perform the following as responsibilities of the County to the City:

- 1. Provide law enforcement services for the City in a conscientious and good faith effort to effectively enforce the laws of the City, County, State and Federal governments and to maintain peace and order within the City.
- Provide for the administration, communications, education, training, employee resources and supervision of assigned enforcement officers by the Sheriff.
- 3. Provide personnel, equipment, insurance, maintenance of equipment, supplies, and operational expenses of assigned enforcement officers necessary to accomplish the terms of this Contract and Agreement.

It is understood and agreed by all parties to this Contract and Agreement that:

- 1. The Sheriff shall determine which officers shall perform duties in a given area and the time and manner in which duties will be performed. Residence locations of deputies assigned law enforcement responsibilities under this contract shall be at the sole discretion of the Sheriff.
- 2. No joint acquisition or ownership of property will be required under this Contract and Agreement. All property owned and purchased by the County, both real and personal, under the control of the Sheriff may be utilized at the discretion of the Sheriff in carrying out his official statutory duties and those duties contemplated in this agreement. All property owned or purchased by the County, both real and personal, under the control of the Sheriff for use as provided by this agreement shall remain the property of the County.
- Prior to February 15, 2022, the County will notify the City of the amount of contract consideration assessment required for the following year's law enforcement contract.
- 4. This Contract and Agreement may be terminated by any of the parties by notice in writing at least sixty (60) days prior to the effective date of the termination.
- Notice to any party shall be given by delivery or mailing same to the City Clerk, in the case of the City, to the County Auditor, in the case of the County and in the case of the Sheriff, to the Office of County Sheriff.

"Communications" for purposes of this agreement, and as referenced as County responsibilities to the City, means communications for the sheriff and deputy sheriffs only. Emergency communications, including 911 dispatch services,



O & M Report: January 2021

Water Operation & Maintenance

- > I completed our annual water use report and sent to the DNR. This report tracks how much water we pump per year and is required to be completed every January.
- ➤ Ben and changed bag and cartridge filters. I have been noticing the cartridge filters have been increasing in fouling during change outs. I will be keeping a close watch on these and may increase the frequency of change outs.
- > I had conducted several water leak inspections for residents. I was able to identify all the sources of running water for each resident and they will be fixing their leaks. Most of the sources were running or improperly set toilets.
- ➤ I was called to 91 W 3rd St for no water issue. I inspected the line in the basement and confirmed their service line was frozen. A door had been left open to the basement from the outside and the heat tape was not plugged in, causing the line to freeze. The meter is still functioning properly and will not need changed.
- > 11 Door postings, 1 disconnect.
- Plowed snow several times through the month.
- > 1 locate, complete.


> We switched LS1 and LS2 to VFD bypass to prevent the cold weather from shutting down the VFDs. They will remain this way until the overnight temps rise above negative temps.




- > We had a regular inspection of the water system from the DNR at the end of December. Overall, the inspection went great. The inspector did note some minor deficiencies, all pertaining from when the plant was built. They recommended we raise some of the access manways on the clear well and lower the overflows. I had disputed these with him during the inspection as to why they were being noted almost 15 years after the plant was built and never noted on any other inspection before. We are not being required to make these changes, but if we did, they would cost around \$20,000 or more to complete.
- During the inspection, the DNR is now required to take a manganese sample from our source entry point. The sample was analyzed and measured a non-detect, or level below the threshold, but since we test for manganese on a daily basis for raw water, we will be required to test for manganese on finished water daily as well. There will also be an annual lab analysis for manganese. The permit has been revised to reflect these changes are being implemented by February 1st, 2021. The additional testing will cost around \$800 extra per year.

Re: SF 159

Transferring lowa's public-school dollars to private schools is a mistake. Competition between schools is not the route to improved education. EVERY school in lowa should be reaching academic standards and it is your responsibility to work with school districts to make that happen. Vouchers will not accomplish improvement in education as shown by studies in states that are using them.

Financially this plan is derelict in its promise to fully fund lowa's schools, which already suffer from insufficient financial support on the part of the state. Allowable growth has not been adequately financed for 10 years and reducing school budgets even more by drawing money from public education and not replacing it, not auditing it, and not ensuring that it is being used in equitable, diverse, and verified ways is nothing more than the political manipulation of funds being done at the expense of our children and the future of this state.

Finally, as council members of a small community we have concerns about the ripple effect vouchers could create at the local level. Have you thought about the conflict that will be created as continually underfunded schools must contend with cities for property tax revenue? Small communities identify with and are closely tied to their school districts. We need each other but cannot afford to compete for local dollars that do not exist.

Unless you fully fund EVERY school in the state with the goal of making them ALL successful, school vouchers are a mistake for Iowa – please prevent passage of this bill.

136.01 PURPOSE. The purpose of this chapter is to enhance safe passage by citizens on sidewalks, to place the responsibility for the maintenance, repair, replacement or reconstruction of sidewalks upon the abutting property owner and to minimize the liability of the City.

136.02 **DEFINITIONS.** For use in this chapter the following terms are defined:

- 1. "Broom finish" means a sidewalk finish that is made by sweeping the sidewalk when it is hardening.
- 2. "Defective sidewalk" means any public sidewalk exhibiting one or more of the following characteristics:
 - A. Vertical separations equal to three-fourths (3/4) inch or more.
 - B. Horizontal separations equal to one (1) inch or more.
 - C. Holes or depressions equal to three-fourths (¾) inch or more and at least four (4) inches in diameter.
 - D. Spalling over fifty percent (50%) of a single square of the sidewalk with one or more depressions equal to one-half (½) inch or more.
 - E. Spalling over less than fifty percent (50%) of a single square of the sidewalk with one or more depressions equal to three-fourths (34) inch or more.
 - F. A single square of sidewalk cracked in such a manner that no part thereof has a piece greater than one square foot.
 - G. A sidewalk with any part thereof missing to the full depth.
 - H. A change from the design or construction grade equal to or greater than three-fourths (3/4) inch per foot.
- 3. "Established grade" means that grade established by the City for the particular area in which a sidewalk is to be constructed.
- 4. "One-course construction" means that the full thickness of the concrete is placed at one time, using the same mixture throughout.
- 5. "Owner" means the person owning the fee title to property abutting any sidewalk and includes any contract purchaser for purposes of notification required herein. For all other purposes, "owner" includes the lessee, if any.

- 6. "Portland cement" means any type of cement except bituminous cement.
- 7. "Sidewalk" means all permanent public walks in business, residential or suburban areas.
- 8. "Sidewalk improvements" means the construction, reconstruction, repair, replacement or removal, of a public sidewalk and/or the excavating, filling or depositing of material in the public right-of-way in connection therewith.
- 9. "Wood float finish" means a sidewalk finish that is made by smoothing the surface of the sidewalk with a wooden trowel.
- 136.03 REMOVAL OF SNOW, ICE AND ACCUMULATIONS. It is the responsibility of the abutting property owners to remove snow, ice and accumulations from sidewalks within forty-eight (48) hours. If this has not been done within twenty-four (24) hours, notice will be posted on the door of the address and 24 hours later the City will have the snow removed at the rate of fifty cents (50¢) per linear foot of sidewalk. The property owner will be mailed a bill from the City to be paid within thirty (30) days of receipt. Any bills left unpaid will become a lien against the property in the following spring after all snowfall. The eight (8) sidewalk located on the east side of Ella Street from 2nd Street to Blackberry will be maintained by the City of Riverside.

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 364.12[2b & e])

136.04 RESPONSIBILITY FOR MAINTENANCE. It is the responsibility of the abutting property owners to repair, replace or reconstruct, or cause to be repaired, replaced or reconstructed, all broken or defective sidewalks and to maintain in a safe and hazard-free condition any sidewalk outside the lot and property lines and inside the curb lines or traveled portion of the public street.

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 364.12 [2c])

136.05 CITY MAY ORDER REPAIRS. If the abutting property owner does not maintain sidewalks as required, the Council may serve notice on such owner, by certified mail, requiring the owner to repair, replace or reconstruct sidewalks within a reasonable time and if such action is not completed within the time stated in the notice, the Council may require the work to be done and assess the costs against the abutting property for collection in the same manner as a property tax.

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 364.12[2d & e])

136.06 SIDEWALK CONSTRUCTION ORDERED. The Council may order the construction of permanent sidewalks upon any street or court in the City and may specially assess the cost of such improvement to abutting property owners in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 384 of the Code of Iowa.

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 384.38)

- 136.07 COMPLIANCE WITH CITY STANDARDS. No person shall remove, reconstruct or install a sidewalk unless such person removes, reconstructs or installs the sidewalk in accordance with the City standards for such work.
- 136.08 SIDEWALK STANDARDS. Sidewalks repaired, replaced or constructed under the provisions of this chapter shall be constructed in accordance with the City's sidewalk specifications on file in the office of the City Clerk.
- 136.09 BARRICADES AND WARNING LIGHTS. Whenever any material of any kind is deposited on any street, avenue, highway, passageway or alley when sidewalk improvements are being made or when any sidewalk is in a dangerous condition, it shall be the duty of all persons having an interest therein, either as the contractor or the owner, agent, or lessee of the property in front of or along which such material may be deposited, or such dangerous condition exists, to put in conspicuous places at each end of such sidewalk

and at each end of any pile of material deposited in the street, a sufficient number of approved warning lights or flares, and to keep them lighted during the entire night and to erect sufficient barricades both at night and in the daytime to secure the same. The party or parties using the street for any of the purposes specified in this chapter shall be liable for all injuries or damage to persons or property arising from any wrongful act or negligence of the party or parties, or their agents or employees or for any misuse of the privileges conferred by this chapter or of any failure to comply with provisions hereof.

- 136.10 FAILURE TO REPAIR OR BARRICADE. It is the duty of the owner of the property abutting the sidewalk, or the owner's contractor or agent, to notify the City immediately in the event of failure or inability to make necessary sidewalk improvements or to install or erect necessary barricades as required by this chapter.
- 136.11 INTERFERENCE WITH SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS. No person shall knowingly or willfully drive any vehicle upon any portion of any sidewalk or approach thereto while in the process of being improved or upon any portion of any completed sidewalk or approach thereto, or shall remove or destroy any part or all of any sidewalk or approach thereto, or shall remove, destroy, mar or deface any sidewalk at any time or destroy, mar, remove or deface any notice provided by this chapter.
- 136.12 AWNINGS. It is unlawful for a person to erect or maintain any awning over any sidewalk unless all parts of the awning are elevated at least eight (8) feet above the surface of the sidewalk and the roof or covering is made of duck, canvas or other suitable material supported by iron frames or brackets securely fastened to the building, without any posts or other device that will obstruct the sidewalk or hinder or interfere with the free passage of pedestrians.
- 136.13 ENCROACHING STEPS. It is unlawful for a person to erect or maintain any stairs or steps to any building upon any part of any sidewalk without permission by resolution of the Council.
- 136.14 OPENINGS AND ENCLOSURES. It is unlawful for a person to:
 - 1. Stairs and Railings. Construct or build a stairway or passageway to any cellar or basement by occupying any part of the sidewalk, or to enclose any portion of a sidewalk with a railing without permission by resolution of the Council.
 - 2. Openings. Keep open any cellar door, grating or cover to any vault on any sidewalk except while in actual use with adequate guards to protect the public.
 - 3. Protect Openings. Neglect to properly protect or barricade all openings on or within six (6) feet of any sidewalk.
- 136.15 FIRES OR FUELS ON SIDEWALKS. It is unlawful for a person to make a fire of any kind on any sidewalk or to place or allow any fuel to remain upon any sidewalk.
- 136.16 **DEFACING.** It is unlawful for a person to scatter or place any paste, paint or writing on any sidewalk.

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 716.1)

136.17 **DEBRIS ON SIDEWALKS.** It is unlawful for a person to throw or deposit on any sidewalk any glass, nails, glass bottle, tacks, wire, cans, trash, garbage, rubbish, litter, offal, or any other debris, or any substance likely to injure any person, animal or vehicle.

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 364.12 [2])

136.18 MERCHANDISE DISPLAY. It is unlawful for a person to place upon or above any sidewalk, any goods or merchandise for sale or for display in such a manner as to interfere with the free and

uninterrupted passage of pedestrians on the sidewalk; in no case shall more than three (3) feet of the sidewalk next to the building be occupied for such purposes.

136.19 SALES STANDS. It is unlawful for a person to erect or keep any vending machine or stand for the sale of fruit, vegetables or other substances or commodities on any sidewalk without first obtaining a written permit from the Council.

Greetings to each of you. I hope this report finds you healthy, happy and warm. I was fortunate to have these meetings and opportunities this past week. Here's my summary:

Michael Gould - IA Economic Development Authority

Michael is our go-to person for IEDA. He works with 22 counties in eastern lowa. His focus is business growth, job retention and recruiting workers to our area. He doesn't do anything with retail or professional services. His projects are usually minimum \$1-2 million with 10 new jobs. If a company has started the project, it's too late. Michael will send info on: High Quality Jobs Program, IA Project Questionnaire, and our wage threshold. He mentioned that with the federal New Market Tax Credit program, it's very complex but saves companies 22-25% of capital investments.

Adam Bentley- ECICOG virtual meeting.

As part of the Cares Act, there's a \$25,000 Rural Recovery (and Resiliency) Challenge for Eastern Iowa. There are 5 total awards and 3 are already spoken for. Jones Co Econ Development is doing 2 projects: an extensive childcare study and a virtual tour of their downtown area with a local media group. Feed IA First is working on a project expanding immigrant food security. They are looking for Programs or Planning projects.

Washington County Supervisors' Meeting

Acknowledgment of the following: Bell Farm proposed confinement feeding operations, K-9 Donations to Sheriff's office, Contract w/ Tree Town Consultants, Forest City for purchase and training of police dog/German Shepherd.

Fair Board Funding request was discussed. Many new activities planned for this summer. Law Enforcement contracts were discussed for each of the cities in Washington County. Engineer Jacob discussed the Bridge Reconstruction project over the Skunk River. WA County Health, Danielle discussed Covid stats and vaccine distribution.

Second meeting with prospects for Syngenta facility. Met at Washington State Bank with Terry Engelken, Brent Hinson and prospect.

The Governor gave a condensed version of her State of the State address: 80% of IA economy consistently stayed open during the pandemic. \$ was added to education. State Budget is balanced. 3.1 % unemployment. GDP up 36% in 3rd Qtr.

Housing Bill has received much focus with Debi Durham at the helm. An Economic Recovery Advisory Board is working on:

Doubling the Workforce Housing Tax Credit Brownfield/Grayfield extension Iowa Housing Tax Credit Program Removing cap on State Tax Housing Trust Fund. Disaster Relief Funding Main Street Grant Funding

Invest in Iowa Act has been put on hold.

Empower Rural lowa is growing:

Broadband Expansion... of Iowa counties have no broadband. 18% of Iowans have access to affordable internet. Iowa has the 2nd slowest internet speed in the nation, behind Alaska. She's proposing \$150mil in next 3 years with Cares funding combined.

We need to continue to grow the population in IA and also focus on Placemaking!
