This plan will help us to continuously improve and adapt our strategies and floodplain modeling efforts for a better English River Watershed.

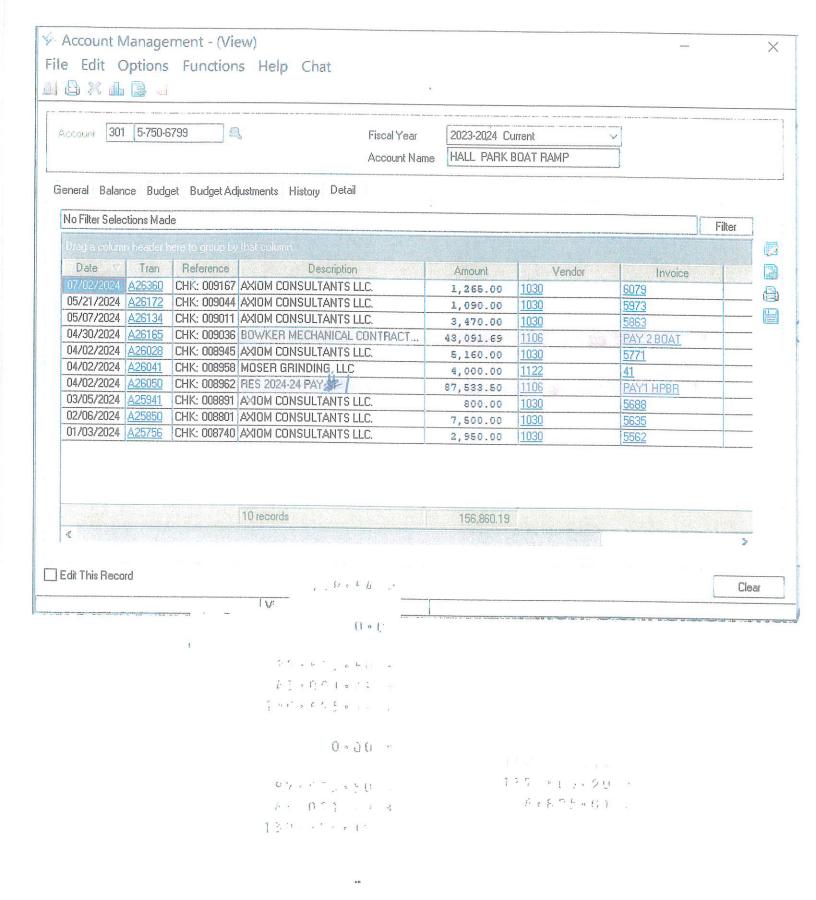
