TRICK OR TREAT- Thursday, October 31st from 5:30 -7:00 pm. Please turn on your porch light to welcome Halloween visitors.

TREE MAINTENANCE- It is the responsibility of the adjacent homeowner to trim the trees over the street and the sidewalk, as well as in the alleys. Trees hanging low are a danger to walking residents, also resident and city vehicles. Trees are to be trimmed 15' above the street and 8' above sidewalks.

Leaves will be falling soon, and remember that burning of leaves is only permitted on private property, not on the city street or ROW between the sidewalk and the curb. Yard waste bags can be purchased at City Hall for \$1.65 each, and can be placed at the curb with your recycling and garbage cart for pickup.

City will provide 4 leaf pick-ups, depending on weather, from late October through mid to late November. Rake your leaves to the curb for collection.
