

**NOTICE OF DUTY TO MAINTAIN ALL WEEDS, VINES, AND BRUSH
CITY OF RIVERSIDE, IOWA**

Notice is hereby given to all property owners and occupants in possession or control of property within the corporate limits of the City of Riverside, Iowa, including railroad property, that they are required to maintain their property in compliance with City Code Chapter 162 (Weed Control). Property owners and occupants must control and maintain all weeds, vines, brush, bushes, non-purposefully planted trees less than three (3) inches in diameter, Noxious weeds as defined by the State of Iowa, and any other uncontrolled growth as described in City Code. If such growth is not properly maintained, the City may enter the property to cut, remove, or destroy the vegetation as required by City Code. The cost of cutting or removal performed by the City will be billed to the property owner or occupant in possession or control of the property. If unpaid, these costs will be assessed against the property in accordance with City Code.

This notice is published annually prior to April 15 in accordance with City Code Section 162.02.
